In the same fashion, Methuselah, the wine, was born from the efforts of the second-generation at Enoch's Stomp. The grapes of this premium wine originated from the vineyards of Ancestry Cellars in Chelan, Washington, where they were fermented and barreled before immigrating to Enoch's for finishing touches.

Left bank (Cabernet dominant) French Bordeaux blend, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Sangiovese, Merlot & Petit Verdot

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2019 - TIMMONS — \$53

Full Bodied West Texas Grapes. Timmons Vineyards, 18 months in French Oak.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2018 - WASHINGTON — \$51 (\$44)

Full bodied, Washington grapes fermented in Texas. 20 months in French Oak.

GSM NV — \$46 (\$40)

Rhone Valley Inspired Blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvedre. Full Body, Dry Red Wine with Notes of Lush Dark Fruits, Savory Herbs, and Chocolate.

MOURVEDRE 2018 — \$45 (\$38)

Full body, similar to Cabernet, dark berries, black pepper, cocoa, West Texas grapes, Narra vineyards.

NV- ELLEN'S SONG — \$43 (\$37)

Full-bodied wine. Lenoir grape. Lees aged for 4 months then barreled for 24 months. Dark berries, fig, savory. Estate

2018 GRENACHE — \$37 (\$32)

Medium bodied, dry red wine with soft tannins. Washington.

MERLOT 2018 — \$30 (\$25)

Medium Body, Dry Red Wine. Notes of Cherry, Plum, Vanilla, and Spice.

BLESS HER HEART NV — \$28 (\$24)

Dry Rose wine. Merlot grapes from Sulphur Bluff, East Texas.

2019 CHAMBOURCIN — \$27 (\$23)

Medium bodied, limited production, estate grown.

HUMBLE NV — \$48 (\$41)

Right bank (Merlot dominant) French style Bordeaux blend. All Texas grapes: Merlot, Sangiovese, Malbec, Petit Verdot.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2019 - TEXAS — \$53 (\$46)

Full bodied West Texas grapes, Narra Vineyards. 18 months in French Oak.

SYRAH 2019 - TEXAS — \$46 (\$40)

Full Body, Dry Red Wine. Notes of Blueberry, Black Plum, Milk Chocolate, Vanilla, and Green Peppercorn.

CABERNET FRANC 2019 — \$45 (\$38)

Full Body, Dry Red Wine, Made With Texas grapes. Notes of Strawberry, With a Hint of Tobacco, Spice, and Florals.

NORTON 2019 — \$38 (\$32)

Full bodied, touted as the "Cabernet of the East." Black cherry, black current, dill, peppery, estate grown.

SANGIOVESE 2019 — \$37 (\$31)

Full bodied, West Texas grapes, French oak.

ALL Y'ALL NV — \$33 (\$28)

Blend of Five Texas Grown Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Villard Blanc, Petit Verdot, and Viognier. Medium Body, Dry Red Wine.

2019 NEBBIOLO — \$29 (\$25)

Light red color yet intense fruit flavors, natural high acidity and tannins. Cherry, strawberry, rose and violet. West Texas grapes.

2018 ZINFANDEL — \$28 (\$24)

Medium-full body, blackberry, peach, cinnamon, Zin Valle vineyards, Canutillo, West Texas.

DRY WHITE WINES

CHARDONNAY 2019 — \$33 (\$28)

Medium to Full Body, Dry White Wine. Notes of Yellow Apple, Pineapple, and Butter. Made From Washington Grapes Fermented in Texas.

VIOGNIER 2020 - WASHINGTON — \$29 (\$25)

Apricot, spice, nutmeg, Washington grapes fermented in Texas.

2019 VIOGNIER OAK W.D. - TEXAS — \$27 (\$23)

Apricot, peach, spice, nutmeg, heavy French oak.

VIOGNIER -2019- UNOAKED - TEXAS — \$27 (\$23)

Apricot, peach, spice, nutmeg, West Texas High Plains grapes.

2013 VERMENTINO — \$24 (\$20)

Pink grapefruit, peach, dried herbs, West Texas grapes.

SAUVIGNON BLANC 2019 — \$29 (\$25)

Floral and tropical fruit flavors, passion fruit, lime, honeysuckle. Washington grapes fermented in Texas.

PINOT GRIS 2020 — \$29 (\$25)

Light Body, Dry White Wine. Notes of Nectarine, Peach, and Almond. Made from Washington Grapes, Fermented in Texas.

2019 SEMILLON - TEXAS — \$27 (\$23)

Rich, creamy, mango, yellow peach and papaya.

2017 VILLARD BLANC — \$25 (\$21)

Similar to Chardonnay, buttery, hazelnut & melon, estate.

SWEET RED WINES

SUSAN'S SECRET 2021 — \$28 (\$24)

Light Body, Sweet Blush Wine. Similar to White Zinfandel with Notes of Tropical Fruits and Strawberry. Estate grown.

CWEET CYNTHIANA 2020 — \$28 (\$24)

Full bodied sweet red wine, dark fruit flavors with a touch of peppery spice & oak, estate grown.

BLU BAYOU 2022 — \$26 (\$22)

Sweet, crisp blueberry wine. Light and refreshing summer-style wine. Locally grown at Alexander farms.

SWEETART - NV — \$29 (\$24)

Cousin to Potter's Hand. Fruity aromatic muscadine, light red. Very sweet

SWEET LENOIR 2020 — \$28 (\$24)

Medium bodied rose wine, reminiscent of Sangria.

SWEET WHITE WINES

RIESLING 2019 - WASHINGTON — \$27 (\$23)

Light Body, Sweet White Wine. Notes of Sweet, Yet Acidic Green Apple. 4% residual sugar.

BLANC DU BOIS SWEET 2020 — \$25 (\$21)

Similar to Riesling. Sweeter than the off dry version with 5.0% residual sugar, estate grown.

MUSCAT CANELLI 2019 — \$27 (\$23)

Fragrant. Floral, honeysuckle & orange blossom, 5.6% residual sugar, West Texas.

DESSERT WINES

2020 MARLA'S MELODY — \$24 (\$21)

Potent sweet white dessert wine, reminiscent of a rich orange liqueur, 18% alcohol, 11% residual sugar, estate grown, 375ml

SKINNY BLUE 2021 — \$24 (\$21)

Enoch's first-ever blueberry dessert wine. Made with locally grown blueberries. Being Blue never tasted so good!

ENOCH'S DARK PORTEJAS 2014 — \$44 (\$37)

Rich semi-sweet red Port-style wine, barrel aged for 3+ years, bottle aged for 1-2 years, Lenoir grape, high alcohol 19%. Estate grown.

2020 ELLEN'S SWEET SONG — \$24 (\$21)

Complex, sweet red wine with dark berry flavors, 14% residual sugar, estate grown, 375ml
